

## **Insurance Requirements**



## **GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE**

Persons requesting special use within selected Anoka County properties will be required to provide a minimum of \$100,000.00 General Liability and, if necessary, umbrella insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence, combined single limit insurance of Bodily Injury and Property Damage which includes the County of Anoka 2100 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, Anoka MN 55303 as additional insured. This coverage shall be primary to the Additional Insured.



## **SERVING BEER AND/OR WINE (INDOOR FACILITY)**

Insurance including liquor and host liability coverage.



## **CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE WITH ADDITIONAL INSURED ENDORSEMENT**

County of Anoka 2100 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave Anoka, MN 55303 should be listed as the Additional insured. A copy of the additional Insured endorsement is needed if the following statement is on the Certificate that reads: "if the certificate holder is an ADDITIONAL INSURED, the policy(s) must be endorsed. A statement on this certificate does not confer rights to the certificate holder in lieu of such endorsement(s)."

A copy of the Certificate of Insurance that verifies the required insurance is in full force throughout the term of permit and must be submitted to the Anoka County Parks Department administrative office two weeks (14 days) prior to the scheduled event.

You must procure and maintain in full force and effect during the term of the permitted event, insurance coverage for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the Permit Event by you, your agents, representatives, employees, volunteers or subcontractors. The insurance coverage shall satisfy the requirements set forth by Anoka County, which is incorporated herein.

You agree that you will hold harmless, indemnify, and defend Anoka County, its commissioners, officers, agents and employees against any and all claims, expenses (including attorney's fees), losses, damages or lawsuits for damages arising from or related to providing or failing to provide the Permit Event for which this special permit is issued, including but not limited to the negligence of you.

Failure to submit the Certificate of Insurance two weeks prior to the event will result in cancellation of the Special Use Permit.
