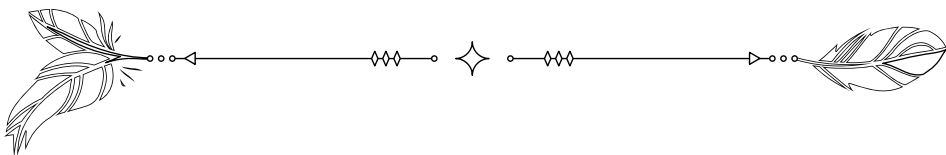

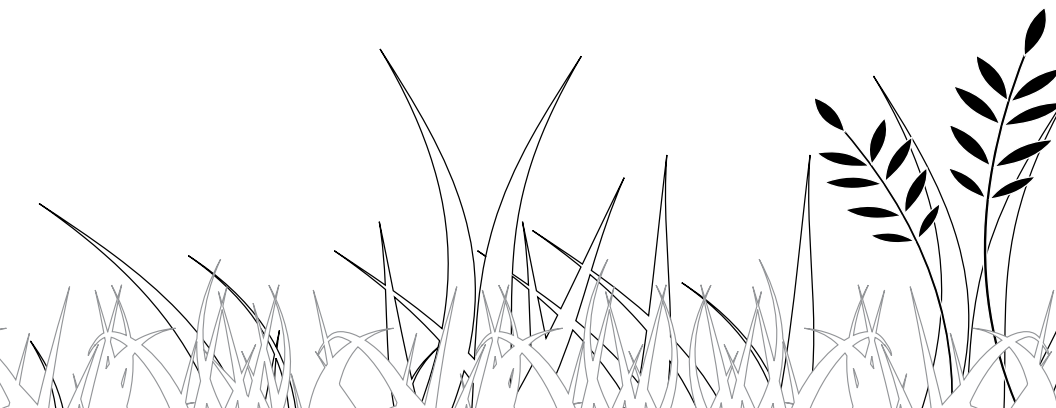
Welcome to the Wargo Nature Center. We are looking forward to working with you to develop exciting, relevant environmental education programs for you and your students/group. Our naturalists are highly trained and experienced in working with groups of all ages and abilities. They are dedicated to helping others learn about, experience, and enjoy our natural environment.

The Wargo Nature Center is a 10,000 square foot facility located in the Rice Creek Chain of Lakes Park Reserve. It is situated on a wooded peninsula along the shores of George Watch Lake. Students have access to the lake, woods, marsh, and prairie ecosystems. Our nature education group sizes are kept with a small student naturalist ratio. If your class is unable to come to the nature center, we would love to bring our programs to you. Offsite programs include an additional travel fee of \$50 for schools within 10 miles of the nature center and \$100 for those beyond 10 miles. Pricing for Individual Program:

\$8.00/student for Extended Day (4-hour) program

\$4.50/student for (1-2 hour) program

\$10.50/student for the year

Extended day programs provide 3.5 hours program time with a thirty minute lunch. Students are given the opportunity to spend more time exploring and learning about our environment. 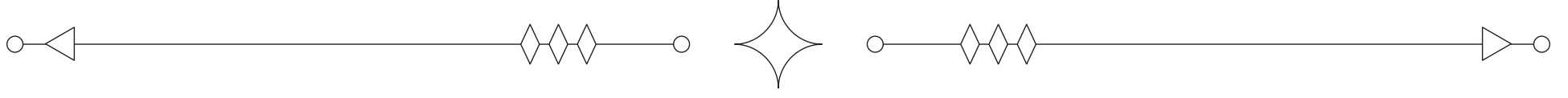
